**DOCK DAY is June 11<sup>th</sup>**

The Chamber's Community Docks go in the north end of Skaneateles Lake on June 11<sup>th</sup>. **Work will begin at 9 am.** We should finish up no later than 2 pm, hopefully, earlier if all goes well.

Every pair of hands makes a big difference, so even if you can only come for an hour or two it would be greatly appreciated. Work boots or sneakers and work gloves are necessary for landwork. A wet suit is necessary if you are willing to work in the water. It is still pretty chilly!
