The Skaneateles Veterans Memorial Committee, reappointed by the Skaneateles Town Board on December 2, 2010, is in the process of starting an addition to the Shotwell Park Memorial Park to honor those service men and women who have served in Grenada (August 24, 1982-July 31, 1984), Panama (December 20, 1989 – January 31, 1990), Persian Gulf/Iraq/Afghanistan (August 2, 1990- Present). The Committee will announce more news on Memorial Day of 2011.

Any Veteran from the Town of Skaneateles who has served actively during any of the fore mentioned conflicts is encouraged to submit an application along with a copy of their DD 214 or Officer Record of Service if discharged. If still on Active Duty or Active Reserve, send a copy of Military ID to the Veterans Committee for possible inclusion on this plaque. Applications are available at Skaneateles Town Hall, Village Hall and American Legion Posts 239 and 317.

Names will be added until conclusion dates for each conflict is determined by the United States Government.

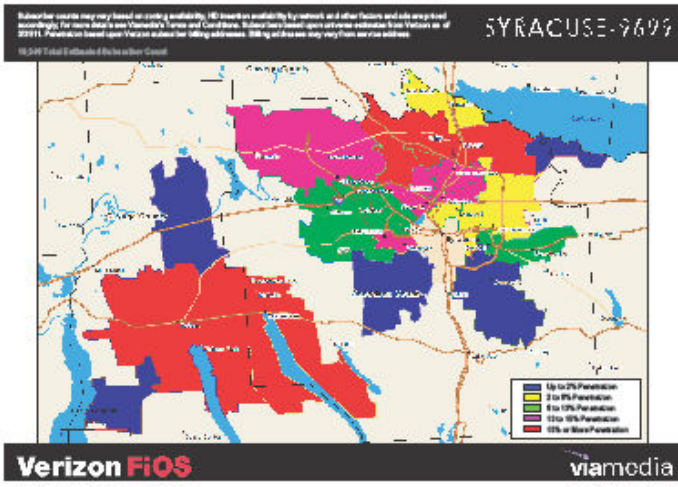
Professional Services Committee presents a networking and educational experience on June 15th from 5-7:30 pm at the Skaneateles Country Club.

Skaneateles Historical Society News

In May the Skaneateles Historical Society's The Creamery will be open Fridays and Saturdays from 1-4 pm, with research assistance available on Fridays or by appointment.

On May 14-15 we will be participating in the National Heritage Weekend, so we will also be open on Sunday from 1-4 pm. We will be highlighting an exhibit of paintings by Skaneateles native DeCost Smith, as well as a display of old Skaneateles samplers.

The Skaneateles Historical Society's May 24th program will feature Eileen McHugh, author of *Auburn Correctional Facility*, part of Arcadia Publishing's Images of America series. What is now called Auburn Correctional Facility is the oldest continually operating prison in the country. Auburn's claim to being the preeminent American prison is bolstered by its many firsts: Auburn was the first prison to house the inmates in individual cells, the first to institute what later became known as the Auburn System of inmate management, the first to employ a chaplain, and the first to put a matron in charge of the women inmates. In 1890, Auburn became the first prison anywhere in the world to use electricity for capital punishment. Eileen McHugh is the director of the Cayuga Museum of History and Art, and Auburn city historian. She has drawn upon the museum's extensive photographic archives to create a moving visual history of the prison.

The public is invited to join us at 7:30 on May 24th at the Museum at the Creamery, 28 Hannum Street.

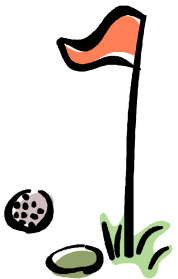
